THE U-S DEPARTMENT OF LABOR YESTERDAY ANNOUNCED THE ALLOCATION OF 400-THOUSAND DOLLARS TO HELP WITH THE FLOOD SITUATION IN RAPID CITY. THE MONEY WILL BE USED TO PAY ABOUT 500 HIGH SCHOOL AGE PERSONS UNDER A NEIGHBORHOOD YOUTH CORPS PROGRAM, AND 150 ADULTS WHO ARE UNEMPLOYED OR UNDER-EMPLOYED. ALL OF THE WORKERS ARE EXPECTED TO BE INVOLVED IN REHABILITATION OF THE FLOOD-DEVASTATED AREAS UNDER THE COMMUNITY ACTION PROGRAM.
