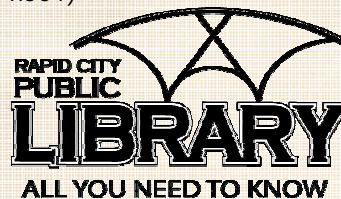
Lunch & Learn: Fire Safety & Prevention

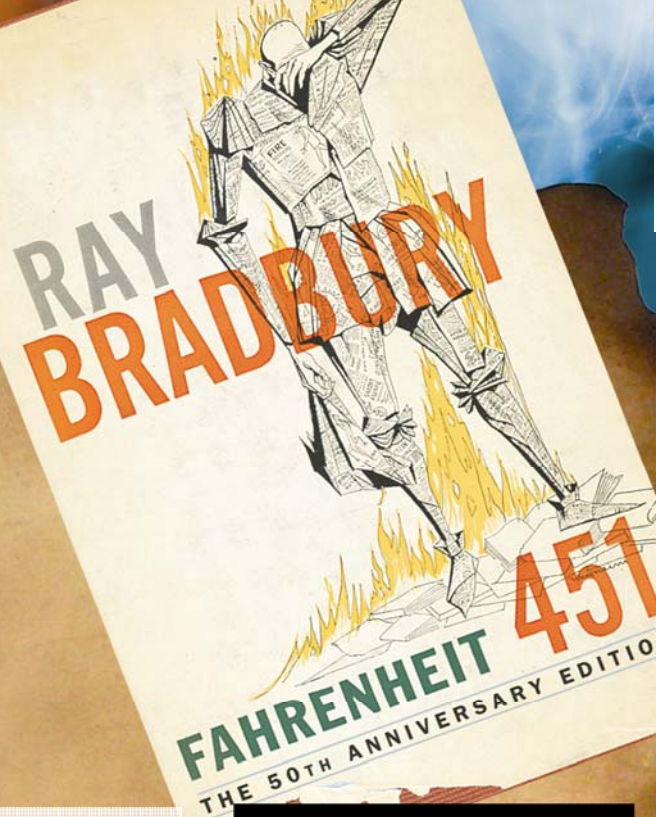
